ARTIST INFORMATION

Mallika Sarabhai has been one of India's leading choreographers and dancers for over three decades. In constant demand as a soloist and with her own dance company, Darpana, she creates and performs both classical and contemporary works.

She first came to international notice when she played the role of Draupadi in Peter Brook's *The Mahabharata* for five years, first in French and then English, with performances throughout France, North America, Australia, Japan, and Scotland.

Always an activist for societal education and women's empowerment, Mallika began using her work for change in 1989 when she created the first of her hard-hitting solo theatrical works, *Shakti: The Power of Women*. Since then Mallika has created numerous stage productions that have raised awareness, highlighted crucial issues, and advocated change. Many of her productions have toured internationally as well as throughout India.

In the mid 1990s Mallika began to develop her own contemporary dance vocabulary, creating short and full-length works that have been presented in India and in over 50 other countries. Dr. Mallika Sarabhai has a PhD in Organizational Behavior and has been honorary director of Darpana Academy of Performing Arts for 40 years.
