To help empower women in this area, one of our partner NGOs organized a self-help group (SHG), or a group of women from similar backgrounds, in the village.

Meera joined the group. Then one day, her husband assaulted her.

She sought advice from her fellow SHG members, who assured her this incident would not be ignored. They promised to use their new strength of solidarity to create change.
