World Health Day is April 7. How will you make a difference?

The Thar Desert, which spreads across the western half of Rajasthan, is the most densely populated desert on the planet. Here, food and water is scarce. Education is minimal. Extreme gender discrimination is rampant.

And healthcare, sadly, is virtually nonexistent.

Two years ago, we partnered with a local NGO to bring lifesaving care to children and mothers in multiple Thar villages, with a focus on community participation to encourage self-sufficiency. With help from this program, hundreds of pregnant women now receive critical health checkups, and women as well as children undergo training on nutrition, hygiene, and disease prevention.

In the second year of the project, 300 women and 903 adolescent boys and girls received health training, and more than 300 pregnant women received prenatal care that was once completely unavailable.
