Make Healthcare Accessible for All

Our Healthcare to Unreached Signature Program (H2U) fights to overcome healthcare challenges within disadvantaged groups. With the help of our NGO partners in India, we provide mothers and children with supplements, education, and resources about diseases and basic comprehension of healthcare.

Our focus is and has always been on prevention. We do this by supporting programs that are repeatable — that is, they have been created with the intention of improving over time for use in other populations with similar needs.



Our 2020 Accomplishments

Despite many hardships in 2020, we made great strides toward our goals and served a total of 21,000 direct and 130,000 indirect beneficiaries. Through partnerships with various NGOs, we were able to bring comprehensive healthcare resources to individuals and communities in Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, and Manipur.

Goal: In **Rajasthan** – improve nutrition and health, and validate a holistic model for the future.

Impact: Successfully reached 5 villages and 5,000-6,000 women.

Goal: In **Gujarat** – decrease infant and maternal mortality.

Impact: Delivered lifesaving resources to 1,200 beneficiaries, including 584 children.

Goal: In **Gujarat** – prevent anemia and provide diagnoses and treatment for mothers and newborns in tribal areas.

Impact: Successfully reached 4,000 beneficiaries across 600 villages.

Goal: In **Gujarat** – provide early diagnosis of breast and cervical cancer, and distribute HPV vaccinations.

Impact: Provided 3,000 mammograms, 2,000 PAP smears, and 1,000 vaccinations.

Goal: In **Maharashtra** – provide general healthcare, immunizations, and prevent infant and maternal mortality.

Impact: Successfully reached 70,000 direct beneficiaries and 40,000 indirect beneficiaries in 25 villages.

Goal: In **Tamil Nadu** – deliver maternal and pregnancy care for landless labor communities.

Impact: Provided care for 100 women and newborns.

Goal: In **Manipur** – provide comprehensive healthcare and COVID-19 awareness and rehabilitation resources.

Impact: Successfully reached 5,548 beneficiaries in Kangpokpi and 3,764 in Imphal West.
