Fundraising Successes

Just before COVID-19 took hold, each K4K member recruited three new members — not only increasing participation and interest in the group, but also increasing the total funds raised. (Each new member donated \$130.) These funds provided an additional 23 underprivileged students in India with tuition, notebooks, and pencils, and raised the total number of children funded to 255. The K4K members are working hard towards their goal to educate 500 children.

In recent months, the group shifted their efforts to focus solely on raising funds for COVID-19 disaster relief. To date, they have raised nearly \$2,900 for this cause.
