Meet Sabitri Devi

Sabitri Devi lives in the Hazaribagh district of Jharkhand, where she and her husband have struggled for years to make ends meet. Most days, the couple traveled to a nearby town in search of daily wage labor, though there was often no work available.

But then, with assistance from a women's self-help group supported by Share & Care, Sabitri received training in vegetable cultivation. She and her husband now tend to their own green pea field, which offers a



steady income as well as excess funds for their savings account. Now, Sabitri is committed to helping others like her:

"I am determined to encourage my daughter to pursue higher study and to set an example in my village. I have been appealing to my fellow self-help group the village to cultivate pea. I hope they are watching me and will join me in the coming year."
